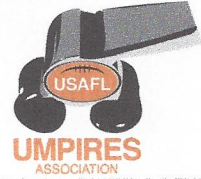

## Caution/Ejection Form

Reason (use back of form if needed): Nashville #13 ran into a group of players following a hard but fair tackle for which holding the ball was awarded. He was yelling as he struck Minnesota #22 with a closed fist; the strike landed on the chest and caused no visual damage. Player left the field upon issuance of the red card/report

### Umpire Responsibility:

- Within 48 hours of a match ending, the Umpire must complete a Caution/Ejection form for each yellow and/or red card issued and email it to the USAFL ([operations@usafl.com](mailto:operations@usafl.com)) and the Tribunals Coordinator ([vp@usaflua.org](mailto:vp@usaflua.org)).
- At Nationals, the umpire must complete the form immediately following the match and either hand it directly to the Tribunals Coordinator or to the Umpires' Tent Administrator.

### Team Responsibility:

1. Any team whose player is issued a red or yellow card must advise the USAFL ([operations@usafl.com](mailto:operations@usafl.com)) in writing of cards issued, providing player name(s) and jersey number(s) only.
2. Teams must submit written evidence to the USAFL ([operations@usafl.com](mailto:operations@usafl.com)) verifying that players have served any suspension.
